



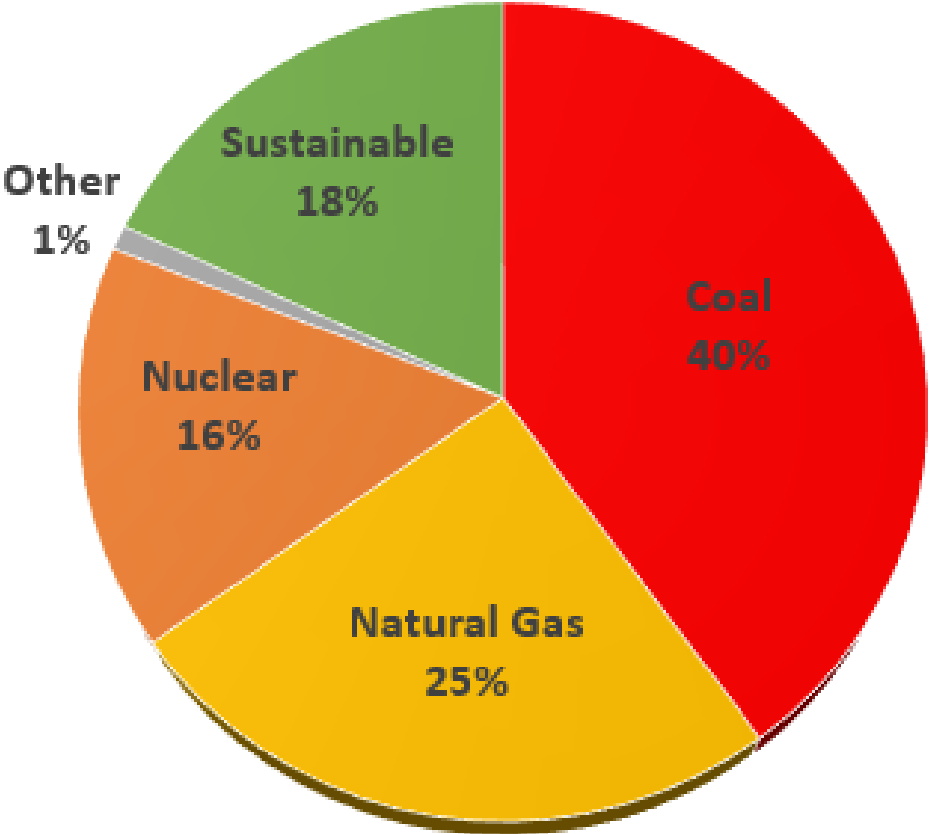

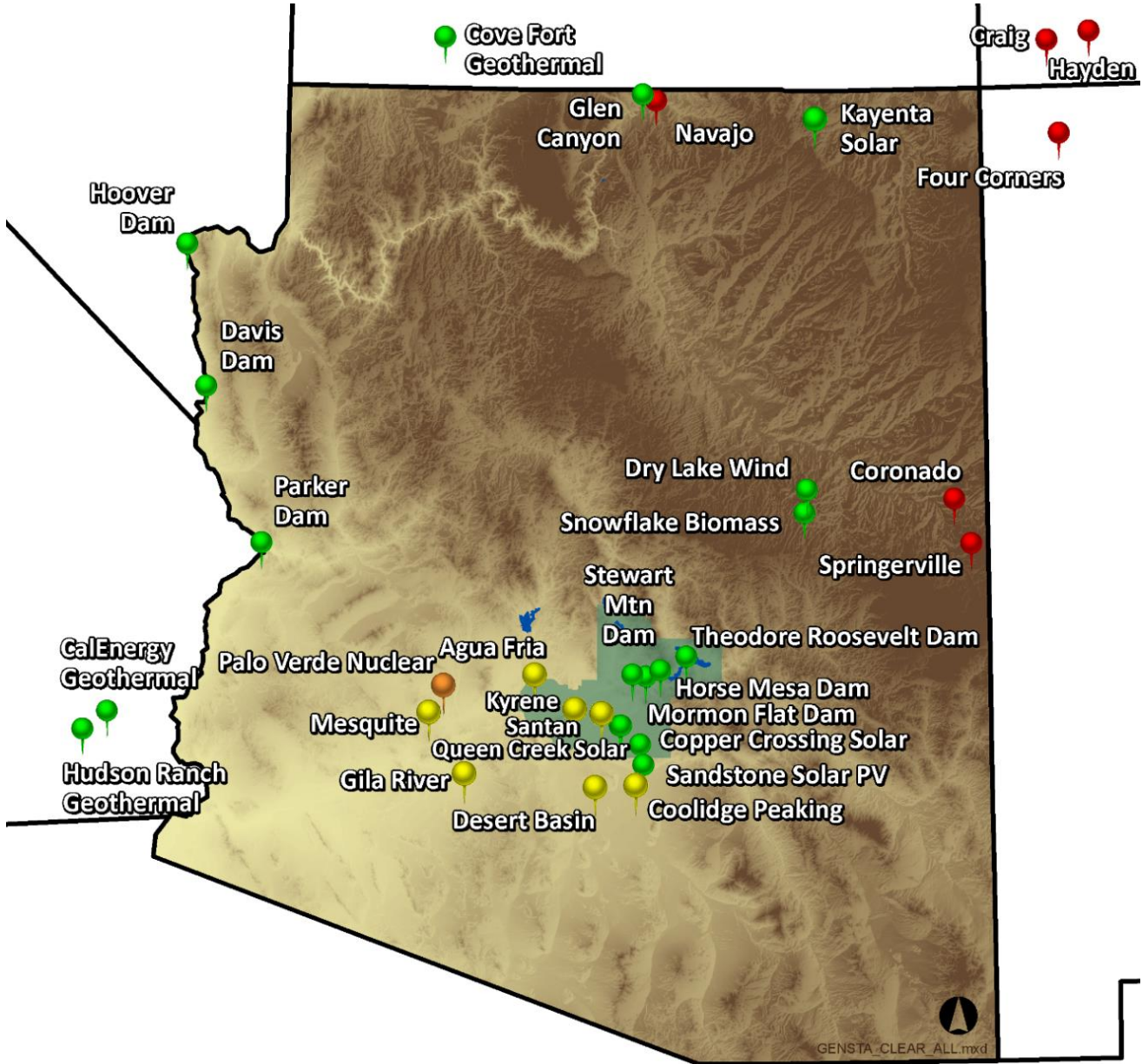

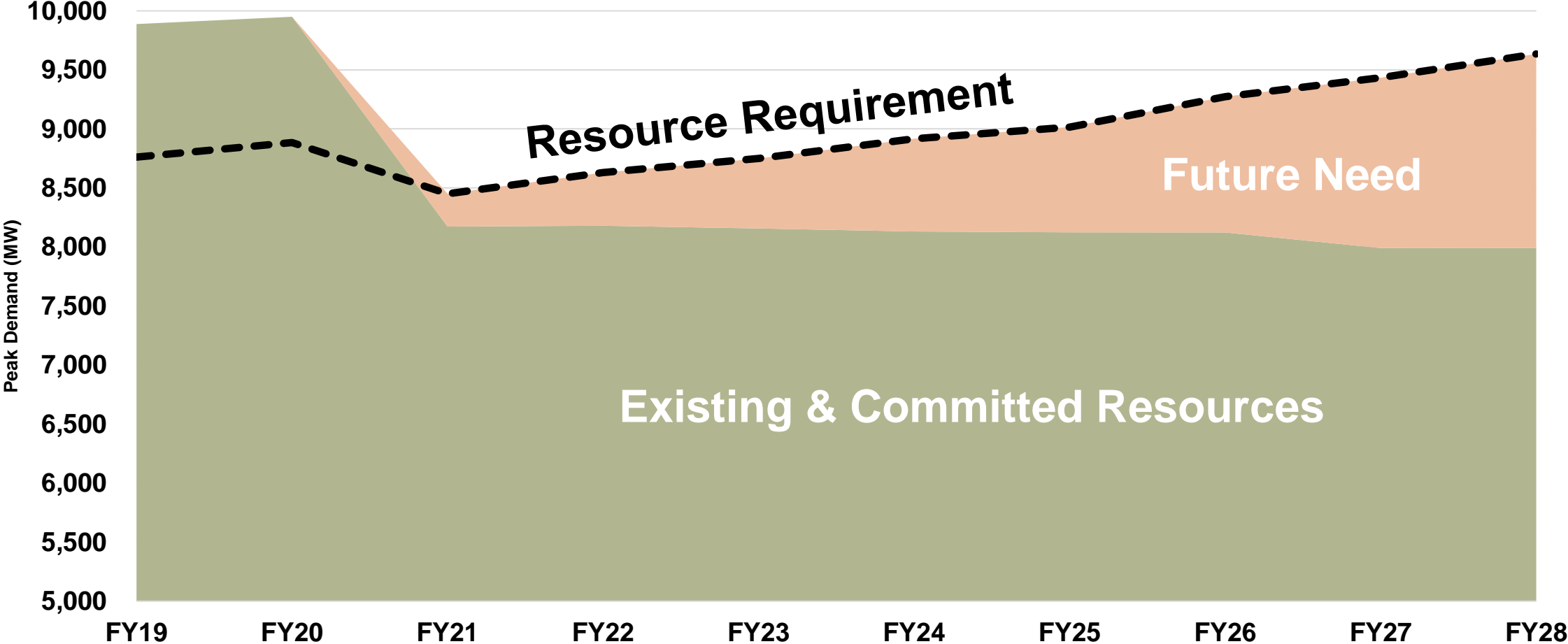

Seek cost effective battery alternatives before making major commitments to new gas generation



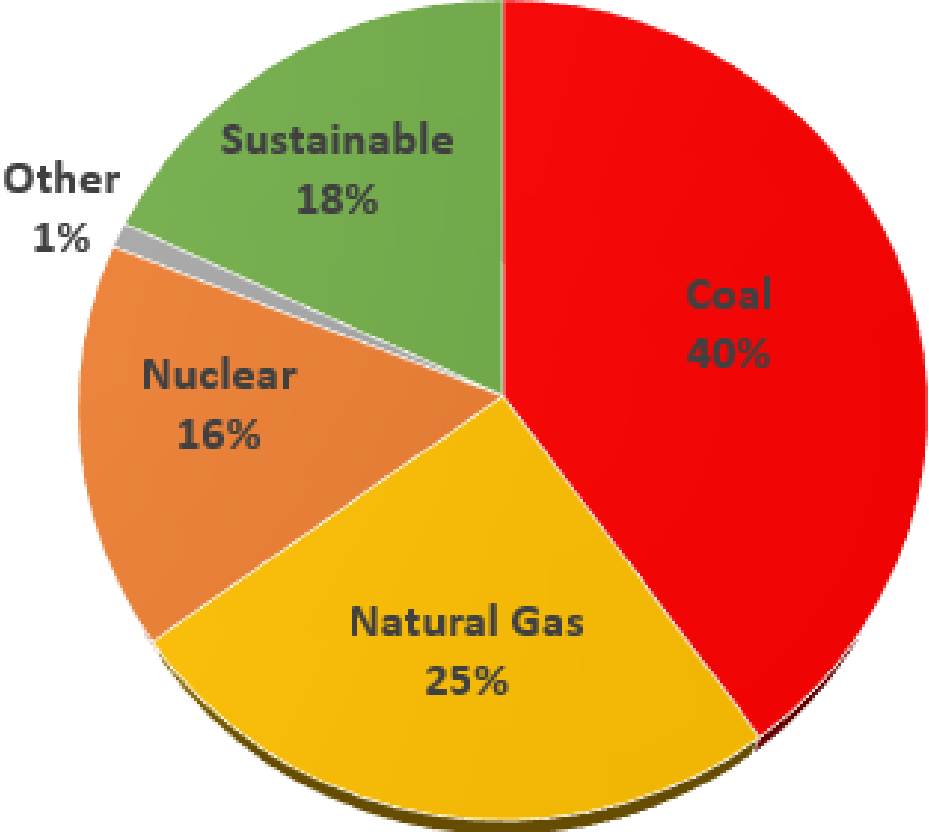
Develop and promote customer programs, focusing on those with peak demand reduction benefits

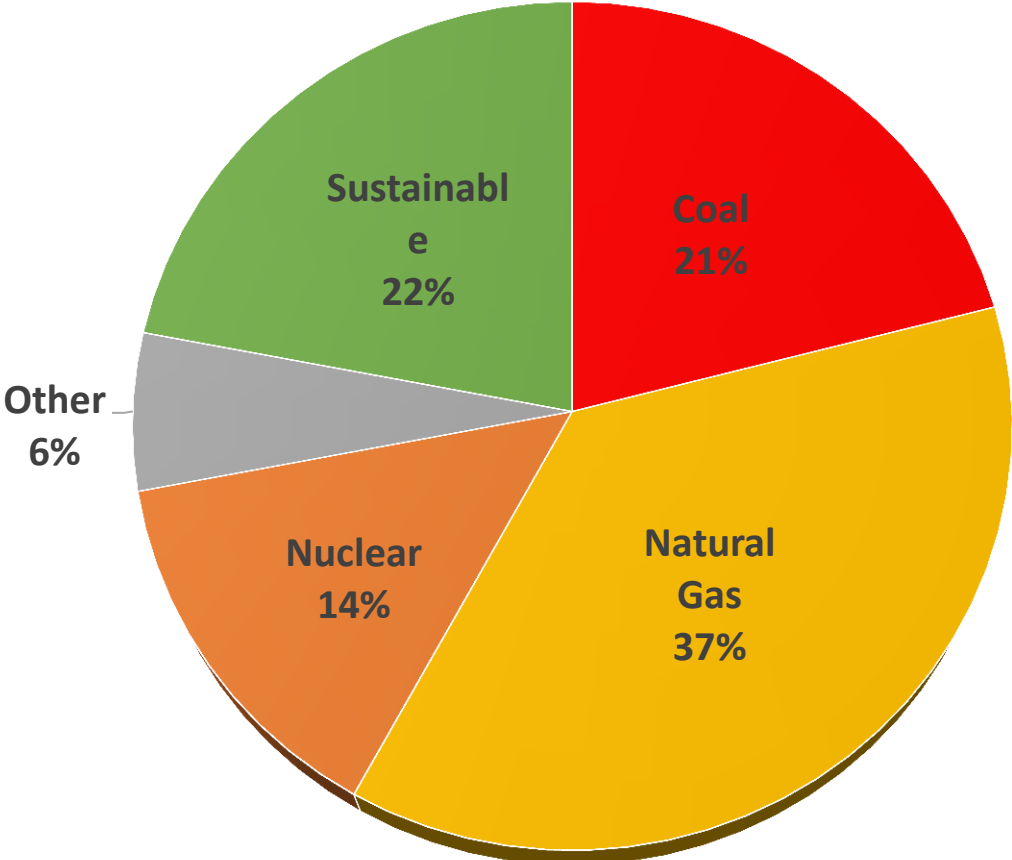
